

## BODEGAS GALLEGAS – DESIGNATION OF ORIGIN "RIBEIRO"

### TECHNICAL DATA SHEET "GRAN ALANIS" WHITE WINE



**Designation of Origin:** Ribeiro

**Age of vines:** 7 to 20 years.

**Density of vines per hectare:** 2.000-3.000

**Number of buds per hectare:** 90-110 thousand

**Production per hectare:** 10.000 - 12.000 Kg.

**Soil type:** Little clayey with granitic origin

**Grape variety:** 85% Treixadura - 15% Godello.

**Precipitation rate:** 900-1.100 liters / m<sup>2</sup> per year

**Cultivation system:** 100% in trellised vines

**Harvest date:** From the second week of September

**Harvesting and grape processing:** The grapes are harvested by hand and transported to the winery in boxes of 18 kilos in less than 2 hours from collection to processing.

Whole process is done in inert atmosphere to prevent chemical and enzymatic oxidation, in order to get the greatest flavor and freshness.

**Elaboration:** "Despalillado" (grapes without residues), maceration, pressing, decanting and fermentation in 60,000 liter stainless steel tanks at temperatures between 14 and 16 ° for 15 days. The microfiltration is performed immediately before bottling to ensure microbiological stability of the wine.

Total alcoholic strength: 12,5% v/v

Dry extract: 23,9 grams / liter

Volatile acidity / Total acidity: 0,26 grams / liter - 5,8 grams / liter

Reducing sugar / Total sulfur dioxide: 3,5 grams / liter // 128 milligrams / liter

Volumetric mass at 20°C: 0,9912 grams / c.c.

**Tasting notes:** Wine that comes from terrain, reflecting a legendary tradition in wine through the merged craftsmanship with modern technology. It is glossy, with lemon yellows and green hues that speak of its freshness. Odor: elegant and intense. Aroma: fruity aromas (apricot, pear and apple), with exotic notes of lychee and lime and floral notes of white petals. The palate shows excellent palate with freshness, friendly and balanced step without losing forcefulness and denoting persistence.
